Cancelled (for disorderly conduct as per NSWGG 2 September 1842). 44/1339, 2 May 1844, 4/4187 (reel 952) Newcastle district, altered for Maitland 2 September 2844. TOLPPT 46/60, 13 February 1846, 4/4260, allowed to remain at Liverpool Plains in the service of John Eales for 12 months.

Sydney Gaol Entrance Book, SRNSW 4/6439 reel 857. #1847, admitted 12 September 1840 for probationary gang, disposed to Parramatta 18 September 1840.

Newcastle Gaol Entrance Book, SRNSW 2/2020 reel 757. #409, admitted 17 May 1843. [Reason is unclear - if it is the same as the entry above it, it relates to cancellation of ticket of leave].
