Gresford 26th Febr. 1900

To the Honorable W. P. Crick
Postmaster-General.

Sir.

We the undersigned residents of Gresford and district, having heard that a petition has been lodged with you, requesting that the Post-Office at Gresford should be moved from its present position to a place more than one mile distant therefrom, beg to submit the following facts for your consideration

1. That the office, as at present situated, is most centrally and favorably located for the whole of the undersigned, and if removed, will lead to a great inconvenience and loss of time
2. That the office is at present right at the intersection of three of the main roads of the district
3. That the present office adjoins the Public School and this is a great convenience, as the children going to school can post letters, and on returning can bring home the mail.
4. That the only people who have signed the contrary petition, and receive their mails at Gresford, have a private bag left at their centre, and the mail coach passes there four times daily
5. That if the office is removed as requested in the contrary petition, it will be distant only three and a quarter miles from an existing Post office at Trefallyn.
